Objective

Who is eligible to participate?

To qualify, participants must be a Malaysian citizen; who is currently studying in a secondary school – Form 3 to Form 6 or Senior Middle 1 to 3 (for Chinese schools) – or a 2018 SPM/STPM graduate.

What should I draw? Theme: THE GREEN CITY

Guidelines

- A2 size (42cm x 59.4cm) painting works in any kind of art media.
- 2. You can send in as many artworks as you like but each person is only eligible for ONE prize only.
- All artworks must be submitted together with an artist's statement (not more than 30 words in either English, Bahasa Melayu or Chinese) that describes their work.
- Each entry must be an authentic work of the participating artist.
- Each entry must be accompanied by a separate and complete entry form.
- Artists are encouraged to submit original works completed within this year or the previous year.
- All art/raw materials must be prepared by the participating artist.
- All artworks must be approved by the school's art teacher or principal.
- All art submissions are the property of the organiser and are non-returnable.
- 10. Except where prohibited by law, an entry submission into this contest constitutes permission to use the winner's name, likeness, prize information, and information provided on the entry form for publicity purposes, without further permission or compensation.

Assessment

A panel of judges will review all eligible entries received and select, at their sole discretion, the entries that are eligible to receive prizes.

The judging panel will evaluate the art submissions based on various criteria such as the originality of expression, creative use of materials and presentation, to name a few. The judges reserve the right to disqualify any entry if there is any reasonable doubt about the authenticity of the artwork.

Prizes to be won

- Champion: ICAD Bursary RM10,000 + Cash Prize RM2,000 + Certificate & Special Token for art teacher
- 1st Runner-up: ICAD Bursary RM8,000 + Cash Prize RM1,500 + Certificate & Special Token for art teacher
- 2nd Runner-up: ICAD Bursary RM5,000 + Cash Prize RM1,000 + Certificate & Special Token for art teacher
- 5 x Consolation Prizes: ICAD Bursary RM3,000 + Cash Prize RM300 x 5 + Certificate students & Special Token for art teacher
- 50 x Finalists: Opportunity to showcase their artwork in an exhibit + Certificate

Artworks received after the closing date will not be accepted. Proof of mail (with postmark) is required. The organisers will not be held liable for any damage or loss to the artwork.

- December (TBC) at UCSI University KL Campus (selected finalists will be contacted by mail, email and phone)
- All winners will be announced on the same day.
- All necessary travel expenses to attend the exhibition will be borne by the participating artist.
